## *Chef Guidelines*

1. Submit soup name and ingredient list to SI Chehalem Valley. This insures a variety of soups and alert guests to possible allergens. Returning chefs please bring a new soup. Registration deadline is September 15th. The first 5-6 professional chefs and 5-6 home chefs to reply will be the lineup.
2. Soup chefs may be an individual, a team or club, one complimentary dinner ticket per soup entry. Professional chefs may send a representative as we know Saturday evening is quite busy for restaurants.
3. Soup needs to be made from scratch except for the broth. Please use fresh, local ingredients, if possible.
4. Home chefs it is ok to cook at home if you follow basic food safety rules. [Click here](#) for more information Call your SI Chehalem Valley contact if you need help to schedule a location and time.

**Plan to spend the evening of Oct. 15<sup>th</sup>, 4:30 to 8:00 pm at the Dundee Community Center, mingling with guests. Keep your soup secret until the winners are announced at 6:30 pm after which you are free to chat about your recipe and techniques used.**

- **Prepare enough soup to fill minimum 6 quart or larger crock pot.**
- **Please bring the soup already heated so that it will be hot at 5:00 pm. If you have extra, please feel free to bring that also.**
- **Bring your own ladle, soup spoon rest (for your ladle), extension cords, clean up cloths, etc.**
- **Please label your items so that we can return items to rightful owners.**

**SOROPTIMISTS will provide mini tasting cups and spoons, tablecloths, napkins, utensils, etc. and any additional foods to round out the meal.**
