Chefs may be individual, team or organization. Professional chefs may send a representative as we know Saturday is a busy night.

Spend the evening of Oct. 19th at the Dundee Community Center (1026 N Hwy 99W) mingling with guests and chefs.

All Chefs

Soup Name and ingredients list from largest volume to smallest, include garnishes. Not a recipe, but for the protection of guests that have dietary or allergy restrictions.

Broths can be commercially made, not necessarily scratch. Whenever possible use fresh, local ingredients.

Preheat a minimum of **SIX (6) quarts** of soup and deliver with a crockpot. We do have some 6qt crockpots if needed, request ahead of time.

Deliver soup from 4:30-5:00pm. If a pick-up is needed please pre-arrange.

Keep your soup secret until the winners are announced at 6:30 pm after which you are free to chat about your recipe and techniques used.

Home Chefs

Home chefs it is ok to cook at home if you follow basic food safety rules. .
